GUIDE DE L'ACHETEUR

D'après la Loi des liqueurs de Québec, un client ne peut acheter qu'une bouteille de liqueur spiritueuse à la fois, mais les commandes de vins ne sont pas limitées. On peut acheter en même temps une bouteille de spiritueux et telle quantité de vin que l'on désire.

La Commission des liqueurs a le monopole absolu de la vente des spiritueux: toute transaction faite en dehors d'elle relativement à ces boissons, constitue une violation de la loi et rend ses auteurs passibles d'amende et de prison. Les hôteliers et les restaurateurs peuvent servir des vins à table à leurs hôtes avec leur repas, mais seuls les établissements de la Commission des liqueurs ont le droit de vendre les vins destinés à être emportés et consommés à domicile. Comme les précédentes, ces dispositions de la loi sont accompagnées de sanctions.

Des dispositions spéciales régissent la vente de l'alcool industriel, et les ventes d'alcool aux hôpitaux, universités et pharmacies, et aux médecins. Tous les intéressés devraient se renseigner auprès de la Commission et en obtenir des formules de commande avant de faire leurs achats.

La Commission fait la livraison des commandes de vins à Québec et à Montréal, y compris Notre-Dame-de-Grâces.

BUYER'S GUIDE

According to the Quebec Liquor Laws only one bottle of spirits may be purchased at a time, though this restriction does not apply to the sale of wines. Wines may be purchased without limit whether at the time of purchasing a bottle of spirits or not.

The purchase and sale of all alcoholic liquors is confined to the Quebec Liquor Commission, and any transactions involving sale or purchase of these beverages by other parties are contrary to law and are punishable by fine or imprisonment. The Commission's Stores alone have the right to sell wines intended for home consumption, though hotels, restaurant-keepers and clubs, if holding permits, may sell wine and beer with meals to their guests within prescribed hours.

Special provisions have been made governing the sale of industrial alcohol and the sale of alcohol for use by hospitals, universities, druggists and doctors. Before placing any orders, those interested should obtain the necessary information, as well as order blanks, from the Commission.

The Retail Stores of the Commission open every morning at 9 o'clock and close at 6 p.m. except on Saturday, when the closing hour is 1 p.m. They remain closed on New Year's Day, The Epiphany, Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, Ascension Day, All Saints' Day, the Immaculate Conception and Christmas Day. Stores will close on days designated for federal, provincial or municipal elections in the districts in which they are situated.

Mail orders should be confined to one of the three following addresses, according to the district in which the sender resides, viz: — Montreal, Quebec or Riviere-du-Loup.

The regulations to the effect that the quantity of wine that may be purchased is not limited, but may include a bottle of spirits and that only one bottle of spirits may be sold at a time, applies also to mail orders.

N.B. — Each order should contain a complete description of the goods ordered as given in the accompanying price-list.

The Commission will forward single bottles of spirits or one or two bottles of wines and one of spirits at one time to any part of the province, free of transportation charges, the only cost to the purchaser being 30 cents per bottle to cover the cost of packing. Larger quantities will be shipped freight or express charges collect.

There is no packing charge on wines purchased by the case.

Orders for wine by the gallon must be accompanied by remittance covering the cost of the containers and packing as given hereafter for wine in jars; and according to the rates given on page 3, for wine in kegs or barrels.

L'expédition est faite aux risques de l'acheteur, qui, en cas de perte ou de dommages, a cependant recours contre la compagnie qui a transporté sa marchandise.

La Commission ne vend qu'au comptant. Les compagnies de transport refusent de transporter des liqueurs payables sur livraison. L'argent doit être envoyé par lettre recommandée. Les chèques certifiés, les traites de banque, les mandats de poste ou d'express sont acceptés, pourvu qu'ils soient payables au pair, à Montréal, à Québec ou à la Rivière-du-Loup, suivant le cas.

Les chèques non acceptés ou certifiés, et tout montant inférieur au prix de la marchandise commandée, y compris s'il y a lieu, les frais d'emballage, seront retournés à l'acheteur.

A moins d'avis contraire de l'acheteur, la Commission remplacera par une marchandise équivalente toute marchandise épuisée ou dont le prix aurait été augmenté. Par ailleurs, la Commission retournera à son propriétaire l'argent payé en excès sur une marchandise dont le prix aurait été réduit.

All shipping is done at the purchaser's risk. He however, has recourse against the express (or other forwarding) company in case of loss or damage in transit.

Transportation Companies will not carry liquors shipped on a C.O.D. basis.

All sales are on a strictly cash basis. Actual cash by mail should always be sent under registered cover. Certified cheques, bank drafts, or money orders are accepted provided they are payable at par in Montreal, Quebec, or Riviere-du-Loup, according to where the order is sent.

Non-certified cheques and remittances which may be less in amount than the cost of the goods ordered, including packing charges, if any, will be returned to the sender.

Unless otherwise instructed by the purchaser the Commission will substitute brands which may not be in stock by another of the same grade. If the price of the brand ordered has been increased since the issue of the price list, a brand of a value equivalent to the amount received will be sent, and if the price has been reduced the difference will be returned to the buyer.

The price of a case of 12 bottles of wine is twelve times the price of one bottle, and the price of a case of 24 half-bottles is twenty-four times the price of one half-bottle.
